I. GENERAL

The following changes, additions, or deletions shall be made to the listed documents as indicated, and all other conditions shall remain the same.

The University has elected to re-open the prequalification process.
General Contractors who attended the mandatory Prequalification Conferences on 10/17/2024 and 10/30/2024 DO NOT need to attend the third mandatory Prequalification Conference scheduled on 12/3/2024 at 11:00 AM.

II. REVISIONS TO PREQUALIFICATION QUESTIONNAIRE

- A. **Delete** all references to the Prequalification Questionnaire submittal due date of Friday, November 1, 2024 at 5:00 PM and Friday, November 8, 2024 at 5:00 PM, and
Substitute the new submittal due date of Friday, December 13, 2024 at 5:00 PM
- B. Refer to Page 2, Item I.D.2
Add the following to the end of this section:
“A third Mandatory Prequalification Conference is scheduled for **Tuesday, December 3, 2024, beginning promptly at 11:00 AM.** Contractors failing to sign in on the official attendance sheet at the prequalification conference will not be eligible to participate in the prequalification process.

- C. Refer to Page 3, Item I.D.4.A
1. **Revise** Item I.D.4.A.4 – Surety as follows:
 5. **SURETY:** Submit a notarized statement from the proposed surety(ies) that states:
 1. Contractor’s current available bonding capacity ~~meets or currently~~ exceeds ~~\$5,000,000 the minimum capacity described in the Questionnaire and can be increased as needed upon the University’s extension/renewal of the Job Order Contract.~~
 2. Contractor’s total bonding capacity.
 3. Surety(ies) proposed to be used on the project is an admitted surety insurer as defined in the California Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120.
 4. Surety(ies) acknowledges its intent to provide bonding of the contract in the event Contractor is awarded the contract.

2. **Revise** Item I.D.4.A.6 – Annual Revenue as follows:
 6. **ANNUAL REVENUE:** Have an annual average revenue for the past three years equal to or greater than ~~\$15,000,000~~.
