 - 3. Surety(ies) proposed to be used on the project is an admitted surety insurer as defined in the California Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120.
 - 4. Surety(ies) acknowledges its intent to provide bonding of the contract in the event Contractor is awarded the contract.

- 2. **Revise** Item I.D.4.A.6 Annual Revenue as follows:
 - 6. **ANNUAL REVENUE**: Have an annual average revenue for the past three years equal to or greater than \$45,000,000.
