

Dear Campus Customers,

Central Plant will be conducting a regularly scheduled high temperature hot water shutdown the weekend of Friday, June 25, 2021 through Sunday, June 27, 2021.

We will be shutting down after 5:00 p.m. on June 25, 2021. Normal service will be restored no later than Sunday, June 27, 2021 at 11:00 p.m.

The purpose of this shutdown is to conduct regularly scheduled maintenance of equipment on the high temperature hot water system and the cogeneration plant. The systems that will be affected during the shutdown will include: building heat, industrial and domestic hot water, and steam generation for cage washers and autoclaves.

The chilled water supply for the buildings and process cooling will not be affected during this shutdown.

This maintenance will help ensure that we provide reliable service to the campus community.
